Symposium fees are a fixed cost covering attendance on both days of the symposium, accommodation on the night of Wednesday 26th May at the Warwick Conference Centre, breakfast, lunches and morning/afternoon refreshments, and an evening meal also held at the Conference Centre on Wednesday 26th May, inclusive. There are no reduced or separate fees for single day attendance, not having accommodation or the evening meal. Registration will open in January 2021. Reduced early bird registration fees will be available up to and including 2nd April 2021.

Registration is via the BIAPWS website www.biapws.org, where there is a link enabling quick, easy and secure credit card payment to be made; a ticket to the event will be issued by return with no further action needed. This is the simplest and quickest method.

If it is necessary to cancel a registration, no fee will be charged if cancellation request has been received by email to BIAPWS@yahoo.co.uk by close of play on 28th April 2021; thereafter cancellation will be charged at 25% of the invoice value up until close of play on 30th April 2021. After this date, no 'cancellation' will be accepted and the full invoice value will be payable.

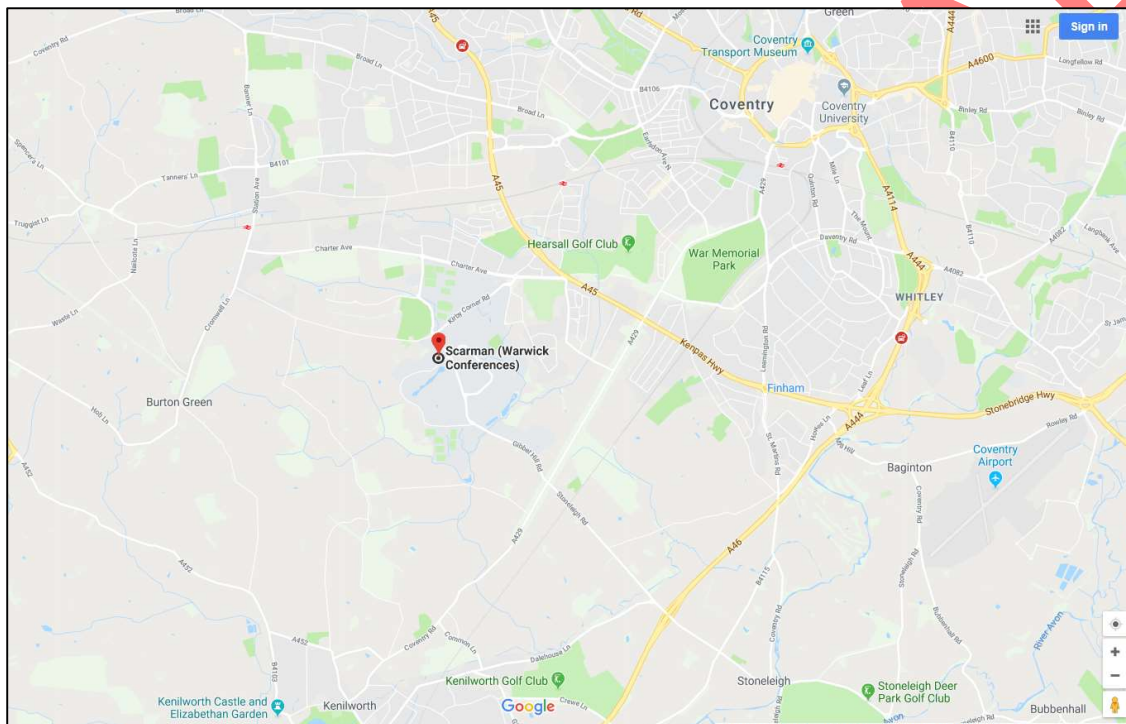

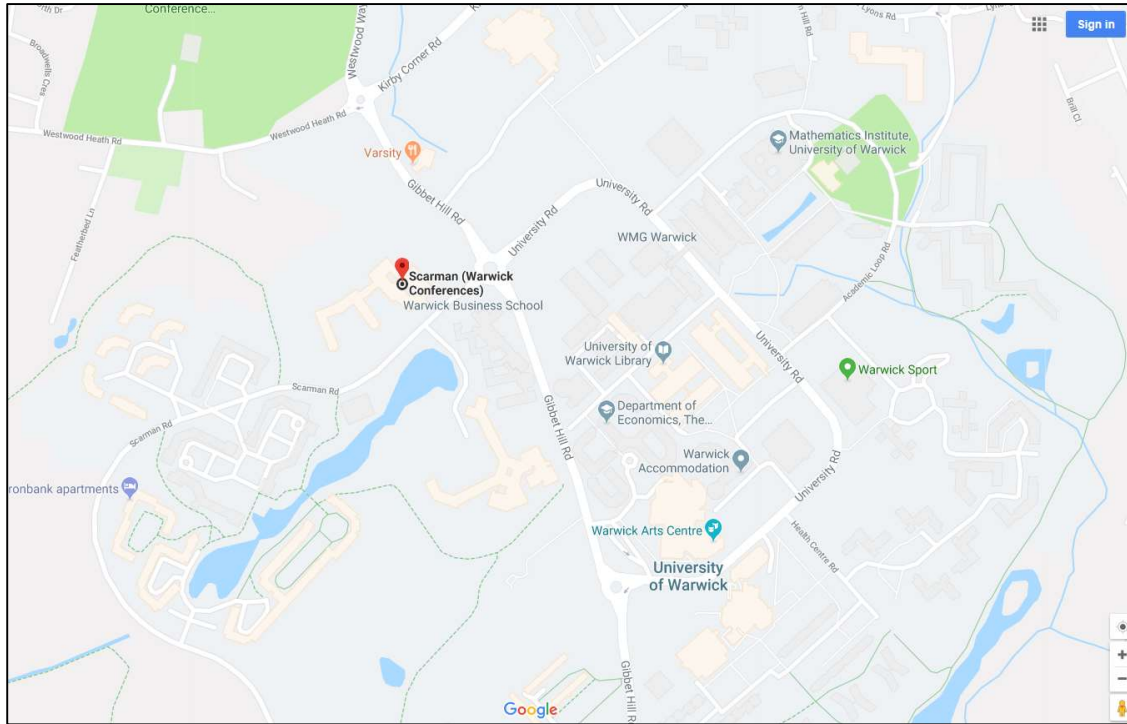
